The Baseball New Brunswick High Performance Program's fall identification camps will be held in Fredericton and Miramichi on Sunday, September 22nd, as well as Moncton and Saint John on Sunday, September 29th. The fall evaluations will be used to identify the winter training rosters for the 17U, 16U, and 15U Commodores.

This camp is an open invitation to Male players that fit into the following criteria:

- Born in 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006
- Registered with a minor baseball association under Baseball Canada

Any Exemptions to the above criteria would need to be approved by the Baseball NB Executive Director and Baseball NB High Performance Chair.

Spring Training – Winter rosters attend on field training and evaluations. 15U team, 16U extended roster, and 17U team will be selected following spring training (April-May 2020)
